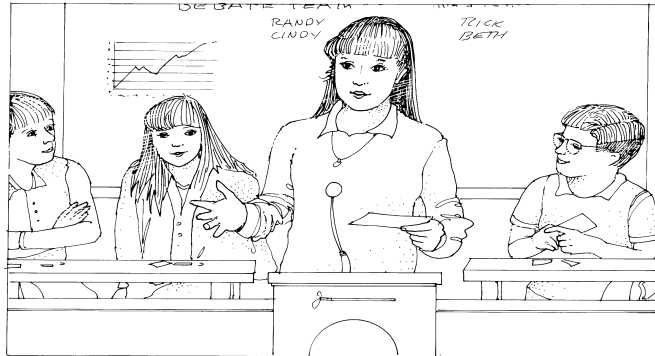


UTAH DEBATE 2011-2012
